THE VALTIERRA'S OUR STORY Indibaajimowinmin

Mino-gizhebaawagad (it is a good day)! God has been so faithful during this season. You may remember receiving our first fundraising booklet. During that time, we had no money, no location, and no people, but we did have faith. Over the last year, God has been faithful. He transformed our faith into a launch team, a location, and enough financial resources to launch a healthy church.

On March 5th, 2020 we welcomed our second son Judah Manuel Valtierra into the world. Judah was born 5 weeks early. Maria had some complications with the pregnancy, but both mom and baby were healthy and are now thriving. We believe God timed his birth just right so we didn't end up in the hospital during the beginning of the pandemic.

Covid-19 set us back several months. Our initial plan was to assemble and train our launch team by the end of July in preparation for our launch in September. Although we were unprepared for Covid, God knew exactly what He was doing. During the pandemic we grew in every way. We experienced spiritual growth in the form of salvations, rededications, water baptisms, and spirit-baptisms. We also experienced numeric growth as our weekly prayer meetings doubled despite having to meet via Zoom. Lastly, God poured out a financial blessing we could not have anticipated as various supporters donated their stimulus checks to the church.

In June, July, and August we hosted monthly gatherings at local parks. Each gathering saw growth in the number of attendees and we ended up water baptizing 10 people.

Chi-miigwech (thank you) for your support thus far. We have felt your prayers and look forward to partnering with you as we move forward.



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Pre-Launch GATHERINGS

These gatherings were held in June, July, and August in local parks. Attendance grew from 40+ to 50+ to 60+ over those few months!

LIVES

Since the first Pre-Launch Gathering, we have seen 10 people get baptized in water, 8 people get saved, 5 people get baptized in the Holy Spirit, and 7 people who completed our new believers' curriculum called First Things First.



Financial BLESSINGS

Through generous givers, we were able to raise \$65,000 prior to the launch. This money funded marketing materials, etc. We appreciate your continued support!

Church LAUNCH

Over 65 people attended the church's launch on September 12. Since the launch, we have continued to see God working through 4 additional salvations and 1 additional Holy Spirit baptism.

Here are several **VICTORIES** we want to share:


LOCALLY

- We successfully launched a healthy church in the middle of a global pandemic
- We have experienced 11 salvations, 7 baptisms in the Holy Spirit, and 10 water baptisms

REGIONALLY & NATIONALLY

- A Federal Missing & Murdered Indigenous Woman's (MMIW) Task Force was created, which prompted individual states to create their own Task Force's. Wisconsin's Task Force was created in July, 2020
- The Little Shell Band of Chippewa Indians (Montana) received federal recognition by the federal government after many years fighting in court *Six other tribes have recently received federal recognition as well
- A Supreme Court ruling determined that a large sum of land be returned to the Muscogee Creek Nation in Oklahoma
- In October of 2020 new legislation, the Durbin Feeling Native American Languages Act of 2020, was introduced to ensure the federal government is protecting & promoting indigenous languages
