LETTER FROM The Pastors

In early October of 2017, I (Jacob) was up late reading the Bible and fellowshipping with the Lord when I received an amazing download from the Holy Spirit. I felt God telling me to write down a very specific set of Scriptures and to "GO" to every tribal community (reservation) in Wisconsin and pray specific Scriptures over the land. We decided that 'Sooner was better than later,' and took off the following weekend on a Friday morning. When we arrived at each destination we prayed and asked God to heal centuries of brokenness starting with each tribal community.

Along the way we were notified that Milwaukee had a large urban Native American population and God immediately led us to begin praying over the city. After a year of prayer, prophetic words, networking and visiting we made the move. We believe we are anointed, called, and equipped to start a church here with an emphasis on reaching urban Native Americans as a fulfillment of Billy Graham's prophecy.

We believe the name THE GATHERING PLACE has a special anointing on it and we pray that the information provided here will stir your spirit to partner with us.





History


The Milwaukee area was originally inhabited by several Native American tribes (Potawatomi, Ho-Chunk, and Menominee), with French traders and missionaries first passing through the region in the late 17th century. After 300 years of contact less than 5% of Native Americans are following Christ.

The Need

- 70-80% of Native Americans live in urban areas across the US
- Health disparities are rampant among Native Americans in Milwaukee (Heart disease, cancer, diabetes, alcoholism, stroke, obesity)
- No pentecostal outreach to Native Americans exists in Milwaukee County
- (55,000 Native Americans live in the Milwaukee metro-area (55,000 Statewide)
- The average age of Milwaukeeans is 31.3 years old
- ⚠ The average family size is 3.37
- Only 11% of Native Americans living in Milwaukee have attained a Bachelor's degree
- The percentage of indigenous language speakers is virtually non-existent
- 31.05% of Native Americans are living in poverty
- The average family income is \$44,000
- There are 22,000 veterans in Milwaukee (6.6% are American Indian); 1 in 2 American Indian males serve in the military; 1 in 4 American Indian women serve in the military
